




Collecting data with Survey123

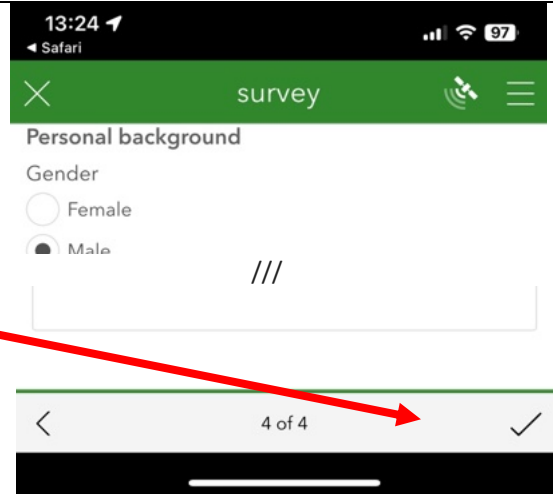
You can add your own collected data into the GIS platform, using your smartphone

| <p>First install the app Survey123 (download for iPhone (Apple Store) & Android (Google Play))</p> |  |
| <p>To start the survey: Scan the QR-code with your smartphone.</p> |  |
| <p>Now the system on your smartphone will ask if you want to open the survey in the browser or in the Survey 123 field app.</p> <p>If you choose the option 'in the browser' you will need too stay connected via wifi or mobile data (4G)</p> <p>If you choose for the Survey 123 app you can also work off line (interesting for remote places where ther's no connectivity).</p> |  |
| <p>If you choose the second option the Survey 123 app opens.</p> <p>You don't need to log in, click on 'Continue without signing in' '</p> |  |



The survey is now downloaded on the smartphone, and you can start collecting data, questions with a red asterisk are mandatory to answer, date and time are filled in automatically.

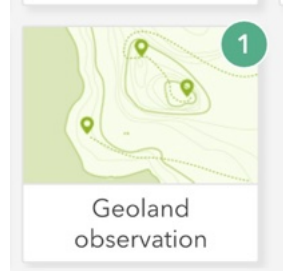
When a form is completed, click the checkmark at the bottom



Now the message 'Survey completed, your device is online' appears (or if you are offline it will say 'Survey completed, your device is offline') with 3 options. Choose the last one: 'Save to Outbox'.

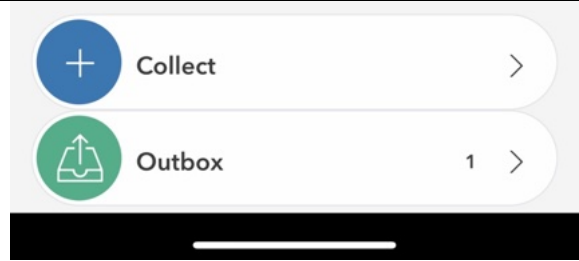


You will enter Survey123's home screen and will see the survey 'Geoland observation' showing a number - the survey in the outbox'.



Open the survey again and now you can do 2 things

- Either do another recording from another survey point (then click on 'Collect')
- Either open the outbox and forward the surveys (internet connection needed again)



When you are done collecting click open the Outbox and click the 'Send' button at the bottom
